Thanks in part to their input, our new lobby is nearly ready to welcome patients and families of all needs and abilities.

The beautiful space features an open plan with stunning views of the St. John’s River. It has expanded seating areas, a new café with outdoor dining, several learning stations, and an art gallery starring our own patients’ masterpieces. The iconic train set also has a new, special place of honor.

While Norah’s family has moved out of the area, they still come to Nemours regularly for multiple specialist visits and surgeries to manage her complex condition. “We’re so excited about the changes,” says Megan. “Norah will have more places to go and things to do while we’re here,” she adds.
