At birth Ana was diagnosed with Down Syndrome and NF1, and most recently Epilepsy. Through all her medical complexities and developmental stages, Nemours has been there for her and her family. From follow-up MRIs to medication management, Nemours ensures that Ana receives the best pediatric specialty care available. Allison, a social worker at Nemours, even made sure Ana was provided a special soft helmet to protect her during the head drop seizures she suffers from, unfortunately not covered by insurance.

Ana is an 8 year old sweetheart who loves music, bright lights and playground swings. If she isn't playing with her two brothers, Noah and Caue, she can be found spending time in her "daddy designed" pink bedroom with custom murals and special toys.

In a few months, Ana will have a follow-up surgery to complete the hip correction. Her family dreams that one day she will be able to walk all by herself and hopefully with little chance of continued seizures. "We cannot say thank you enough to Nemours and

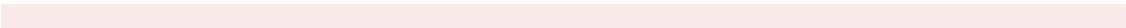

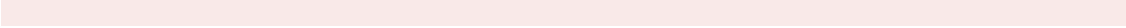
